

Information pursuant to Articles [12\(1\)](#), [14](#) and [21\(4\)](#) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

On the occasion of our first communication to you within the meaning of [Article 14\(3\)\(b\)](#) GDPR, we would like to inform you of the following regarding the processing of your personal data:

To keep you regularly informed about forthcoming public events at ZEW and to potentially invite you thereto, we process your email address and, where appropriate, the following data: your name, title, function, telephone number, place of residence, the name and postal address of your employer. We collect those data through targeted online-research in publicly accessible sources. Subsequently, we will moreover record which events we have invited you to and which events you have registered for or participated in.

Legal basis of every non-economic (within the meaning of section 1 of the Annex to no 2.2 of the German [WGL-Beschlüsse](#)) processing activity at ZEW, and in this case of the processing of your data, is [Article 6\(1\)\(e\)](#) GDPR, read in conjunction with [Article 6\(3\)\(1\)\(b\)](#) GDPR (see also Recitals 41 and 45 GDPR), with §§ 2 und 3 of the articles of association of ZEW of 16 November 2018 and with [§ 65\(1\)\(1\)](#) LHO BW. The processing is namely necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the important public interest of the State of Baden-Wuerttemberg, sole proprietor of ZEW, namely for the non-profit scientific research at ZEW, for which the latter is funded by the German state pursuant to § 1(1) of the German [AV-WGL](#), read in conjunction with § 1(2) of the same and the [Annex to the same](#) as an institution of general scientific-political importance. The processing is thus lawful even without your consent pursuant to [Article 6\(1\)\(a\)](#) GDPR.

We will not disclose your data outside ZEW.

Should you inform us that you no longer wish to receive any information on public events at ZEW, we will thereafter process your data only insofar as necessary to fulfil your request. Otherwise we will store your data for as long as you remain reachable for such communications.

You may exercise the following rights towards us: access pursuant to [Article 15 GDPR](#) in conjunction with [§ 27\(2\)](#) BDSG; rectification pursuant to [Article 16 GDPR](#) in conjunction with Recital 65 GDPR in conjunction

with [§ 27\(2\) BDSG](#); erasure pursuant to [Article 17 GDPR](#); restriction of processing pursuant to [Article 18 GDPR](#) in conjunction with [§ 27\(2\) BDSG](#); objection pursuant to [Article 21 GDPR](#) in conjunction with [§ 27\(2\) BDSG](#). When doing so, please cite 'ZEW-OEFI-Mit14DSGVO (Veranstaltungen Oeffentlichkeit)'.

You may also lodge a complaint pursuant to [Article 77 GDPR](#) with the supervisory authority (Landesbeauftragter fuer den Datenschutz Baden-Wuerttemberg).
