Legal basis of the processing of your data is not your consent pursuant to [Article 6\(1\)\(a\)](#) GDPR, but the public interest. That is to say, every non-economic (within the meaning of section 1 of the Annex to no 2.2 of the German [WGL-Beschlüsse](#)) processing activity at ZEW, and in this case the processing of your data, is based on [Article 6\(1\)\(e\)](#) GDPR, read in conjunction with [Article 6\(3\)\(1\)\(b\)](#) GDPR (see also Recitals 41 and 45 GDPR), with §§ 2 und 3 of the articles of association of ZEW of 16 November 2018 and with [§ 65\(1\)\(1\)](#) of the German LHO BW. The processing is namely necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the important public interest of the State of Baden-Wuerttemberg, sole proprietor of ZEW, namely for the non-profit scientific research at ZEW, for which the latter is funded by the German state pursuant to § 1(1) of the German [AV-WGL](#), read in conjunction with § 1(2) of the same and the [Annex to the same](#) as an institution of general scientific-political importance.
