The reason we are allowed to process your data is, basically, that we do so in the public interest and not because you have given consent to the processing. [That is to say, every non-economic (within the meaning of section 1 of the Annex to no 2.2 of the German WGL-Beschlüsse) processing activity at ZEW, as in this case the processing of your data, is based on Article 6(1)(1)(e) GDPR, read in conjunction with Article 6(3)(1)(b) GDPR (see also Recitals 41 and 45 GDPR), with §§ 2 und 3 of the articles of association of ZEW of 16 November 2018 and with § 65(1)(1) of the German LHO BW. The processing is namely necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the important public interest of the State of Baden-Wuerttemberg, sole owner of ZEW, namely for the non-profit scientific research at ZEW, for which the latter is funded by the German state pursuant to § 1(1) of the German AV-WGL, read in conjunction with § 1(2) of the same and the Annex to the same, as an institution of general scientific-political importance.]

You may exercise the following rights towards us: access pursuant to <u>Article 15 GDPR</u>; rectification pursuant to <u>Article 16 GDPR</u>; restriction of processing pursuant to <u>Article 18 GDPR</u>; **objection** pursuant to <u>Article 21 GDPR</u>. When doing so, please cite 'OEFI-PUR-Mit13-14DSGVO (Verteilung ZEW-Veroeffentlichungen)'. By contrast, because your data are processed in the public interest, pursuant to <u>Article 17(3)(b) GDPR</u> you have no right to have them erased and pursuant to <u>Article 20(3) GDPR</u> you have no right to data portability.

You may also lodge a complaint pursuant to <u>Article 77 GDPR</u> with the supervisory authority (Landesbeauftragter fuer den Datenschutz Baden-Wuerttemberg).

You are not required by law or contract to provide us with your data, nor is such provision necessary to enter into a contract. Without your data, however, we will be unable to regularly offer you our free publications.
