

MANUSCRIPT EDITING STANDARDS

Preceding the text, the following details are to be listed on the manuscript in the following order: (1) title in English language, (2) author name(s) and indication of institution and place, (3) JEL-classification, (4) keywords in English language.

Manuscripts can either be submitted via email (jahrbuecher@zew.de) or as reprints in triplicate and in addition as hard disk copy.

Attachments to the Manuscript

The following attachments are required upon submission:

- two English summaries (a longer version of about 200 words for reprint, the shorter one with no more than 100 words to be forwarded to the Journal of Economic Literature),
- a bibliography. Please attach in direct sequence to the bibliography the author's complete reference address, telephone, fax, and e-mail.

Citations, Footnotes, Bibliography

- Citation specifications: (1) Citations in the running text: Harrod (1933, p. 5) or (Harrod 1933, p. 5), (2) citations in the footnote: *Kaldor* (1940), pp. 78 or (*Kaldor* 1940, S. 78ff.).
- Footnote numerals in the text appearing at the end of a sentence or clause are placed behind the punctuation mark. Footnotes in the main title or with the author's name use the star symbol (*). All other footnotes in the text use superscript Arabic numerals (¹).
- The bibliography is to be edited according to the following samples:

- Please use for numbers in your text, tables and graphs the correct German and English notation, depending on the language of your paper.
German: 10,8 / 5.000.000 English: 10.8 / 5,000,000

Figures (printer's copy)

- All figures have to be sent as eps or tif files. If authors submit their paper by sending it through the post, figures are to be enclosed and printed on clean white paper (not recycling paper!). The figures may also be submitted on separate hard disks (the files have to be saved in eps or tif).
- Please submit black/white copies only. Please observe that a single line's strength must be at least 1 pt. Please do not use thinner lines as they will not show post print.
- Grids are to be avoided.
