SUBMISSION OF PAPERS AND FULL SESSIONS

All individual submissions must include the following information: an abstract of up to 200 words, the author's full name and affiliation, as well as contact details. Please submit only full papers (incomplete drafts are welcome). We encourage submissions of full sessions. Any such proposal must include a short session abstract and the papers (or extended abstracts thereof) to be presented in the session itself. Typically, a session comprises three papers and all presenters should have confirmed their willingness to participate.

All proposals must be written in English and shall be submitted to the organising committee via MacciAnnual2025@zew.de as a PDF file no later than 1 December 2024. Participants interested in discussing a paper without presenting should send a message to the organising committee (MacciAnnual2025@zew.de). Authors of accepted papers will be notified no later than 31 December 2024. Presenters must register by 2 February 2025 and are expected to discuss another paper. Young researchers are particularly encouraged to submit papers.
