

PROFESSOR RICHARD T HARRISON

Richard Harrison is Professor of Management and Director of the School of Management and Economics, Queen's University Belfast. He was previously Dixons Chair of Entrepreneurship and Innovation and head of the Centre for Entrepreneurship Research at the University of Edinburgh Management School, and has held previous appointments at the universities of Aberdeen, Ulster and Queen's Belfast. His major research has been in entrepreneurial finance (particularly business angels and early stage venture capital), technology transfer and the commercialisation of university research, and public policy and economic development: funding for this research has come from ESRC, DTI, Bank of England and EU, among others. He is co-founder and co-editor of *Venture Capital: An International Journal of Entrepreneurial Finance*, which publishes internationally, oriented research and commentary on all aspects of the venture capital business. He has served as adviser/consultant/speaker on venture capital, business angels and financing innovation to a wide range of advisors, policy makers, government and international agencies and economic development interests in the UK, Ireland, USA and Europe. In addition to his academic activities he has associate relationships with a number of venture capital funds and management consultancy practices in the UK and USA. He sits or has sat on the boards of university and HEI technology transfer companies in Ireland and Scotland, dealing with issues of IP and business development. He is author of five books and over 100 research papers and reports on entrepreneurial finance, technology-based businesses and entrepreneurship and economic development.
