

Malcolm White Biog

Since 2004 Malcolm has been the policy adviser at the United Kingdom's HM Revenue & Customs for the tax-based venture capital schemes. He has tax policy responsibility for the Enterprise Investment Scheme (EIS), Venture Capital Trusts (VCTs), the Corporate Venturing Scheme (CVS) and the Community Investment Tax Relief (CITR). In 2004 he was part of the UK Government team that produced the UK Report, "Bridging the finance gap" which led to major changes in how the UK Governments suite of access to finance schemes are structured and which led to the launch of Enterprise Capital Funds (ECFs) in the UK in 2005. Over the last two years he has worked with HM Treasury on the introduction of a package of major changes to the tax based venture capital schemes delivered through the UK Budget in 2006 and 2007. In 2006 he was instrumental in the development of an Econometric research programme (Institute of Employment Research, UK) into the performance of the UK EIS and VCT tax schemes. He has wide experience of presenting at national and international conferences and workshops including NORFACE (Helsinki 2006) and EBAN Annual Conference, (Prague 2006).
