Aneta Wilmańska graduated in International Economic and Political Relations in the faculty of Economics and Sociology of the University of Łódź (2000) and Postgraduate European Studies in the Centre for European Studies of the University of Łódź (2001). In 2006 she started PhD studies on the Warsaw University.

In 2001 Mrs. Wilmańska has started to work in the Ministry of Economy as responsible for issues concerning regional policy and the EU Funds. Next, she was engaged in issues concerning innovation policy and programming Sectoral Operational Programme Improvement of Competitiveness of Enterprises (SOP ICE) under the National Development Plan 2004-2006.

With the beginning of year 2004 she was entrusted with responsibilities of the Deputy Director of the Department Managing the SOP ICE.

She was in charge of preparing and implementing first in Poland pilot instrument on seed capital for SMEs.

At the beginning of year 2006 Ms. Wilmańska became the Deputy Director of Economy Development Department in the Ministry of Economy. She is responsible for coordination of Lisbon process in Poland (under the National Reform Programme 2005-2008) and involved in programming of the Operational Programme Innovative Economy 2007-2013.

She was involved in establishing the National Capital Fund (fund of funds) in Poland and a notification process of the State aid scheme on the NCF activity.
